What's in it for you?

What is ARENU (A-RE-NEW)?

The Association of **R**etirees of Eversource and **N**ortheast **U**tilities is an organization of individuals who have either retired from the Eversource/NU system or are former employees.

What is the purpose of ARENU?

The purpose of ARENU is to encourage good fellowship among its members, to promote recreational and social activities, and any other worthwhile projects of interest to its members. In 1988, a group of retired NU system employees formed ARENU to establish and maintain broad, two-way communications between retirees and NU management.

Although Eversource has generously provided office space and communications services to ARENU, we conduct ourselves as an independent organization of retirees and spouses – maintaining a cooperative relationship with Eversource.

What does ARENU do?

- ARENU invites all members and spouses to participate in periodic entertaining and information-sharing events/meetings held in Connecticut, Massachusetts and New Hampshire. ARENU members who reside in Florida or spend

winters there meet occasionally during winter months. Our newsletter (*A-RE-NEWS*) together with Chapter newsletters, keeps members informed of these happenings.

Guest speakers at these meetings present information and answer questions on topics of interest to retirees and spouses, and some may be invited to entertain.

- ARENU offers spouses of deceased members the opportunity to continue participating in association meetings and activities.
- ARENU members are encouraged to participate in the various activities provided for their interest and enjoyment. Also, many opportunities are available for those members willing to become involved in organizing and helping out with the many activities sponsored by ARENU.
- ARENU publishes a quarterly newsletter titled *A-RE-NEWS* that is aimed at keeping members informed of upcoming events, meetings and programs.

Who belongs to ARENU?

Of approximately 7,500 NU retirees and surviving spouses, more than 3,500 are members of ARENU, including retired employees of CL&P, CYAPCO, HELCO, HWP, NAESCO, NGS, NNECO, NUSCO, PSNH, WMECO and YES. ARENU maintains chapters in Connecticut, Massachusetts and New Hampshire to better serve members who reside in these areas.
